



- 2.4 The Player is obliged to refrain from the use of means and methods that are prohibited according to The Norwegian Olympic and Paralympic Committee and Confederation of Sports' (NIF) regulations.
- 2.5. The player may not, directly or indirectly, bet or gamble on matches where The club's teams are involved, or in any way assist or attempt to assist bribes, or attempts to influence the outcome of, or events in a match through unsportsmanlike behavior. If the player is in contact with individuals who are trying to make the player affect the outcome of the match, or events in a match through unsportsmanlike conduct, The player is required to inform NFF immediately.

3. Equipment and cost reimbursement

- 3.1 The following equipment for matches and training shall be paid by the club, wholly or in part:

- 3.2. After The club's approval, the player can receive a reimbursement of these costs providing approved documentation:

4. Marketing and sponsor activities:

- 4.1 The player cannot enter into personal marketing agreements.
- 4.2 The club has, to a reasonable extent, the right to use The player in marketing and sponsor activities. The player can refuse to take part in commercial or marketing activities, if the participation is in conflict with The player's ethical or moral conviction, or the activities may be in competition with The player's own or employer's business.

5. NFF's regulations

- 5.1 Contents of this contract shall be in accordance with the NFF's regulations and guidelines. If formulations in the contract are contradictory to formulations in NFF's regulations, the regulations shall be considered superior.
- 5.2 During the contract period, the player cannot be granted a permit to play for another club as an amateur player, unless the two clubs and the player agree. An amateur

player cannot, however, be refused to sign a contract as a professional football player.

5.3 At the expiry of the contract period, The player is free to join a new club. In this case, the only conditions The club can set for the transfer, are that The player has fulfilled his/hers financial and contractual obligations.

6. Disputes

Disputes regarding the content of the contract shall, as far as possible, be settled by sports bodies.
